255	The "what" here seems clear. We need to get back inside Flagrante Bello. What is not clear, however, is the "how." This would be a lot easier if the entrance Beth used wasn't covered in a pile of rubble.	255
256	Those Super Mutants had to get to the surface somehow. We may be able to determine access points based on their patrol routes.	256
257	RAHMANI We may. One potential issue is manpower. While we haven't had the opportunity to test the hypothesis that our status as "The Seven" grants us some sort of immunity to whatever is happening there, I'm still not comfortable sending anyone else.	257
258	ODESSA Neither am I. Not that I'm necessarily comfortable going there either right now, but that's the closest thing we have to a "safe" option.	258
259	DEREK Maybe you should stay at Atlas, at least for now. Let us do some recon to make sure it's safe. You know, uh increase the sample size a little?	259
260	ODESSA I don't know if we have time for that. People are going to figure out that the Super Mutants aren't in charge anymore, and somebody's going to make a move. We have to make sure it's us. (beat) (MORE)	260

267	DEREK We could use her expertise, but the three of us are more than capable of going to Flagrante Bello and getting the intel we need to figure out a way forward.	267
268	RAHMANI If we do this, we need to stay focused. Odessa, if you don't feel that you can do that, we can take Scribe Navia instead. She's one of the Seven and the only one we know isn't affected.	268
	BETH enters.	
269	BETH There won't be any need for that, Paladin.	269
270	ODESSA Beth!	270
271	BETH Sorry I'm late. Had to clear my head a bit.	271

We can't assume that all of those Mutants have been taken out by this phenomenon. It's entirely possible that the complex itself is safe and they're holed up in there. We won't know anything until we get inside.
